Exegetical Research Paper Checklist

 Separate, un-paginated title page
 Paper itself begins on top line of page one
 Body of paper is paginated from page one through bibliography page
Intro paragraph introduces paper (no data, no footnotes or quotes) pericope and method (what you will focus on) road map (how you will develop your presentation)
 Method section introduces the method you're using, with reference to sources that describe that method
 Body of paper applies that method systematically to your passage in the steps typical of that method
 When used, sources are appropriately introduced, quoted or paraphrased, discussed, and footnoted
Footnotes are in proper format. Unlike the complete references you provide in the bibliography, when you footnote a source, you cite the specific page or pages from which the quote or idea comes, not the full page-range of the article, essay or chapter.
Parenthetical references are only used for biblical citations; the first time you quote from the Bible, add a footnote after the parenthetical reference to indicate the version of the Bible that you are using, as follows:
Mark's Jesus is aware that his power has been used, but is unaware whom the
recipient is: "Who has touched my clothes?" (Mk 5:30).2

Pastoral application of about 2 pages applies the insights you've gained from research to a particular pastoral experience you've had or issue you face, with special attention to the concerns of the poor and marginalized in your community
 Each paragraph begins with a topic sentence that introduces the paragraph (contents, purpose)
 Each paragraph ends with a concluding sentence that summarizes what the paragraph demonstrated
 Concluding paragraph summarizes what you've demonstrated in the paper (no data, no new ideas, no footnotes or quotes)
 Bibliography page is final numbered page of paper; entries alphabetical by author's last name and formatted properly (see online style sheet)
